Position Summary

Wabun Tribal Council is seeking a dedicated and skilled **Public Health Nurse** to deliver community-based public health services to our First Nation communities: **Brunswick House, Mattagami, Matachewan, Chapleau Ojibwe, and Beaver House**. This role focuses on communicable disease control, prevention, and health promotion, while working in partnership with community health staff to improve overall wellness.

Key Responsibilities

Communicable Disease Control & Management:

- Implement prevention, investigation, follow-up, and reporting of communicable diseases.
- Support outbreak management and case contact tracing in accordance with public health protocols.

STBBI Program (Sexually Transmitted and Blood-Borne Infections):

- Provide education, testing, and follow-up care in collaboration with community health teams.
- Promote prevention strategies and reduce stigma related to STBBIs.

Tuberculosis (TB) Program:

- Conduct screening, monitoring, contact tracing, and treatment support for TB cases.
- Maintain accurate reporting to appropriate health authorities.

Communicable Disease Emergency Management:

- Assist with planning, preparedness, and response activities for public health emergencies.

Environmental Public Health:

- Collaborate with environmental health officers to address concerns such as water quality, air quality, food safety, and housing conditions affecting health.

Harm Reduction:

- Promote harm reduction strategies, distribute supplies, and provide education on substance use and overdose prevention.

Qualifications

Education: Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BScN) from a recognized institution.

Registration: Current registration in good standing with the College of Nurses of Ontario.

Experience:

- Minimum 2 years of nursing experience, preferably in community or public health.
- Experience working with Indigenous communities is an asset.

- Valid Ontario Class G Driver's License.
- Ability and willingness to travel extensively to Wabun Tribal Council communities.
- Excellent communication, cultural competency, and interpersonal skills.
