Wabun is asking members about harvesting and land use in our territories.

This survey is being conducted by the Wabun Tribal Council to better understand the impact of harvesters who identify as Métis and are part of the Métis Nation of Ontario in our Territories.

What you share will support Wabun's legal work, and will help us assess how Métis assertions, harvesting and land use are affecting our people.

WHO CAN TAKE PART

Only members of Wabun First Nations. You will be asked for your name, your Nation and your status number.

It is confidential. Answers are seen only by Wabun staff, contractors and legal advisors. Please do not share the survey outside our First Nations.

WHAT THE SURVEY ASKS ABOUT

Past

What you have heard about any Métis community in your territory, going back generations.

Present

Your own harvesting — fishing, trapping, gathering food and medicines — and where you do it today.

Impact

Harvesting by people who identify as Métis or MNO members, and how it has changed your land use.
